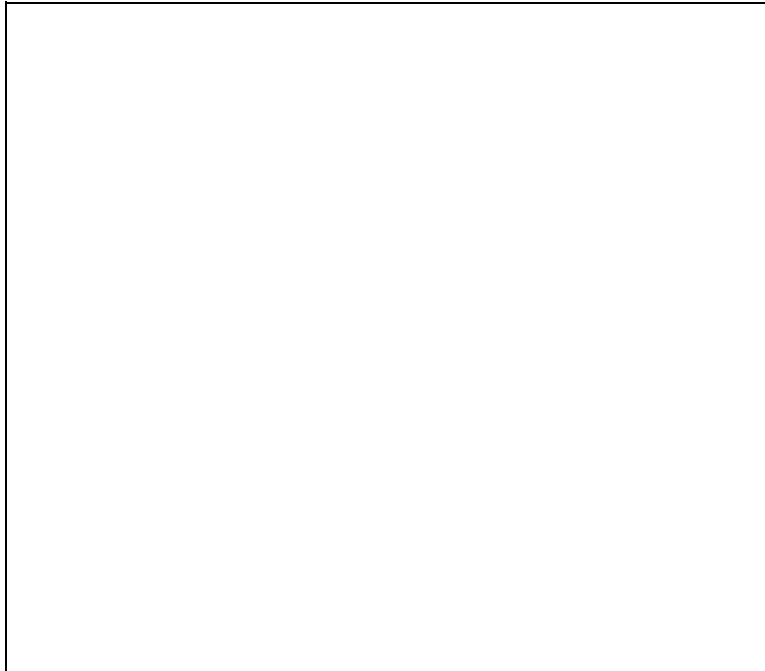

- Compatible with Asus RT-N13U's images. N13U's images are uploaded via UART CLI by tftp client from tftp server on LAN.
