try to reset your router. by power off. press reset. power on and hold it pressed for 15 - 20 seconds

## How to flash back original firmware for WBR-G54

I think a way to flash back original firmware is by editing the original firmware and deleting the header (e.g. WBR-G54 blah blah blah until before HDR0). I have tested it on OpenWRT but have not tested on DD-WRT yet.

## **WBR-G54 - Working Great**

I flashed mine 2 weeks ago and it seems to be working great. I'm trying to tweak the radio tx etc but I'm satisfied with all the options... and still discovering new ones. BTW, you need to modify the generic binary with "hexedit" to put the right header in, otherwise the web interface won't accept the firmware.
