Load Balancing Feature

Enable a load balancing feature to allow traffic to one IP to be redirected to multiple IPs using round robin algorithm. This would allow small business to setup load balancing accross multiple servers.

For instance virtual IP: 192.168.1.200 Real IPs: 192.168.1.201

192.168.1.202

All traffic going to 192.168.1.200 will be round robin between 192.168.1.201 and 192.168.1.202.
